Once your matter has been submitted it will be assessed by the Australian Sanctions Office (ASO). You can track your matter by following the steps below.

Pax detailed statuses and what they mean for your application

PAX DETAILED STATUSES AND WHAT THEY MEAN FOR YOUR APPLICATION	
Detailed Status	Description
Draft application / request	Your application is still in 'draft' and has not yet been submitted to the ASO
Application / request received	Your application has been submitted and received by the ASO
Undergoing preliminary assessment	The initial stage of a review to determine if all the relevant information has been provided
Additional information required	Preliminary assessment has been completed. The ASO require additional information to be provided
Additional information overdue	You have not provided the additional information. You have 21 days to provide the requested information before your application will be Closed – matter inactive .
Intention to recommend denial	Based on the ASO assessment the intention is to deny your permit application. You will have an opportunity to provide additional information that may change the assessment.
Undergoing external assessment	Your application has been referred to another Government agency.
Referred to UN	We have referred your matter to the UN
Undergoing sanctions assessment	Your assessment is with the ASO team and currently undergoing an assessment
Decision pending	The matter is with the decision maker and is awaiting a decision
Closed – permit granted	A permit has been granted – the matter has been closed
Closed – permit denied	A permit has been denied – the matter has been closed
Closed – permit required	The IA matter has been closed and a permit Application will now need to be submitted
Closed – permit not required	A permit is not required – the matter has been closed
Closed – prohibited	The action is prohibited – the matter has been closed
Closed – matter inactive	The matter has been inactive for 90 days – the matter has been closed
Closed – matter withdrawn	The applicant has withdrawn the matter – the matter has been closed
Closed – draft inactive	The matter has been in the draft state for 90 days – the matter has been closed
